

PARADISE GARDENS

Membership Rules and Regulations

(Revised 5-29-06)

In order to maintain a family atmosphere, all members and visitors are responsible to know and abide by the Rules and Regulations of the club. They are for the comfort and safety of all members and visitors to our facility.

- Conduct:** Paradise Gardens is a **Family** nudist resort. Appropriate behavior is expected and required. **Indecent, lewd** or **overtly sexual** behavior is prohibited, and will not be tolerated. Let your guide be: conduct yourself at all times in ways that will not be offensive to others.
- Attire:** Paradise Gardens is a family nudist resort, not a clothing-optional resort. Weather permitting, members and guest are expected to be nude. When nude, sit on your own towel, not on bare seats of picnic table, etc. **NO CLOTHING IS EVER** permitted in the **POOL, HOT TUB, SAUNA** or **SUNNING AREA**.
- Children:** **AT ALL TIMES, Parents** are responsible for the safety and conduct of their children while on the grounds of Paradise Gardens. Please be certain that they understand and obey the rules. Curfew for children is as follows:
1-8 years – 10:00 P.M.
9-12 years – 11:00 P.M.
13-16 years – 12:00 A.M.
Dance night curfew is 10:00 P.M. for all children.
- Language:** Paradise Gardens is a family nudist resort. Please remember that children often hear what you say. Therefore, foul and suggestive language will not be tolerated.
- Residency:** Paradise Gardens is a State of Ohio licensed campground facility. No permanent residents are permitted other than management.
- Alcohol:** Paradise Gardens does not sell or serve alcoholic beverages. Members and guests may bring beer and/or liquor on the grounds for their own use. Members and guests are personally liable for any injury, accident, or loss involving the use of alcohol. Intoxication shall not be tolerated. No underage drinking of alcohol is permitted.
- Glass:** Glass bottles or containers are a hazard to us all. **No glass** bottles or other **glass containers** may be used in the clubhouse, swimming, bathing or sunning areas.
- Lake:** The Lake is for the enjoyment of all members and guests. In the interest of safety, there is absolutely **no swimming** in the lake. Parents are responsible, **at all times**, for the safety of their children on and around the lake. The paddleboats are available for the use by members and visitors. When using boats on the lake there must be a flotation device on board for each occupant. Children under 10 must wear a life jacket.

- Fishing: All bass and catfish in the lake are catch and release, except during designated times such as fishing tournaments, etc. All other fish and turtles may be consumed. Anyone wanting to dispose of fish and turtles must put them in sealed plastic bags and throw the bags in the dumpster beside the Red Barn. No fish or turtles are to be thrown on the bank, left in boats or fish holding devices. Frog gigging is prohibited.
- Illegal Substances: The use of illegal drugs or marijuana is not permitted on the grounds at any time.
- Firearms: Pistols, revolvers, rifles, shotguns, and all lethal weapons are prohibited on the property of Paradise Gardens at all times, with or without a firearms permit, without written permission from the Board of Directors.
- Garbage: A nice club is the job of everyone. Pick up after yourself. All campers should dispose of garbage in the dumpster provided near the red barn. No outside garbage is to be brought to the club for disposal.
- Monthly: Proper attire for that time of the month, should it be needed, are gym shorts or sarongs. No bathing suits, underwear, etc.
- Parties: Some activities at Paradise are designated adult only. In an effort to meet the needs of all our members, some activities are planned for families and some for children. Of course, parents are always welcome at children's parties.
- Check-In: Members bringing guest to our resort must notify the manager upon their arrival.
- Checkout: The checkout time for visitors who stay overnight is 12 noon. After that time, another day's ground fee or camping fee will be assessed.
- Enforcement: Major rules violations could result in immediate expulsion. Normal rules violations will be dealt with first a verbal warning, followed by a written reprimand and then expulsion.
- Payment: To be a member in good standing, all bills due Paradise Gardens must be **paid promptly**. **Your gate card will be suspended** if your bill is past due sixty days, unless prior arrangements have been made. Your gate card will be reinstated when your bill is paid.
- Courtesy & Respect: Members and visitors are expected to avoid the unnecessary disturbance of others at all time. Quiet hour is 1:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m.
- Speed Limit: We love our Children! We ask that **all** drivers observe the 5 mph speed limit. Remember, pedestrians have the right of way at all times.
- Littering: Please keep Paradise looking like Paradise – **DON'T LITTER!** Do not throw cigarette butts on the grounds. Dispose of cigarette butts in butt containers or field strip your cigarettes and put your butts back in your cigarette pack.

- Photos: Any and all photos are not permitted without **prior approval** of the manager. Most nudists are camera shy. If a dispute arises, the manager is authorized to take possession of the camera, film or cell phone.
- Pets: Pets are allowed at Paradise Gardens and must be kept on a leash at all times outside your camping area. Pets are not allowed in the clubhouse, swimming, bathing or sunning areas. Owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pets. Each owner **must** sign an owner of responsibility agreement.
- Swimming Pool: **We have no lifeguard on duty**, so you must **swim at your own risk**. Shower (and use soap) to remove oil, etc. before using the pool. No horseplay, running or pushing will be tolerated in the pool and adjacent areas. Parents are responsible for the safety of their children at all times in the pool area. Only toddlers that are potty trained or wearing swim diapers will be allowed in the pool. No glass containers are permitted inside the pool area. You must be nude while in the pool.
- Sauna: No Children under the age of 12 are permitted to use the sauna unless accompanied by a parent. No smoking or eating is permitted in the sauna. The sauna is not to be used as a dryer. All articles left in the sauna will be confiscated.
- Hot Tub: Shower (and use soap) to remove oil, etc, before entering the hot tub. The minimum age for children to use the hot tub is three (3) years of age. Children ages 3-12 are allowed in the hot tub only with their parent(s). Horseplay is prohibited.
- Sitting: When sitting, a towel must be used.
- Equipment: Please return all equipment to its proper place when finished.
- Golf Carts: Parents or guardians are fully responsible for children driving golf carts. A responsible adult must accompany children under the age of 14. After dark, golf carts must have operable lights. The golf cart driver is responsible for any and all accidents and must obey club speed limits.
- Grounds: Due to our state licensing, no changes can be made to the grounds without prior approval from management. No trees are to be cut down without management's knowledge and approval. Advise the management prior to operating chain saws.
- Camp Sites: Any member who improves their camping site will not receive an increase in site fees for one year after the improvement. After this period of time, the site fee applicable to the site will be applied.
- Storage: Any vehicle or trailer left on the premises for more than ten days will be assessed a \$1.00 a day storage fee beginning June 1, 2006.
